Paul Mendes-Flohr is professor of modern Jewish thought at The University of Chicago Divinity School and until recently the director of the Franz Rosenzweig Research Centre for German-Jewish Literature and Cultural History at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. His research interests are modern Jewish intellectual history, philosophy and religious thought and German intellectual history.
