The title of my seminar is the following: *Designing and evaluating mathematical tasks: which task for what purpose?*

During the seminar I offer insights into my current research concerning the design, the use and the evaluation of mathematical tasks within the TBM-project. My aim is to emphasise the link between the design process of mathematical tasks and the goals for which these are designed. A template for designing and another for evaluating mathematical tasks are presented and, through looking at a particular task, it will be possible to explore the use of these templates. The theoretical frame for the research is Activity Theory.
