SECTION A: (mandatory)

The Kraljic matrix is a basic concept within the purchasing management literature. Please, discuss the relationship between two dimensions of this matrix. What is the practical usage of this matrix? (40%)

SECTION B: (choose to answer TWO of the FOUR following questions)

- 1. Define and explain the most important problems in Lambert et. al's article: "Issues in Supply Chain Management", with a specific focus on chain members, processes, links and integration. How can this model be used in practice? (30%)
- 2. Discuss how and why different supply chains may apply different strategies ("push" and "pull", lean and agile, JIT) for competition in the marketplace. (30%)
- 3. What is safety (buffer) stock? What factors favor high levels of safety stock? Are there any drawbacks of having high levels of safety stock? (30%)
- 4. Why the quality of performance measurement systems was significantly improved since companies had started to implement such tools as "key performance indicators" (KPIs) or "balanced scorecard" (BSC)? (30%)
