A sustainable-democratic approach to social change and knowledge? Dialogue on limits and potentials on action-research from Italian experiences

The talk-seminar aims at discussing some research- and action-driven experiences in action-research in Italy. The dialogue will focus on examples of community-organization processes, social policy research, organizational change in non-profit organizations, and participatory methods in teaching.

Discussion will be based on stories, examples, insights and feelings to reflect on some issues such as (not all of them, probably): how we know what we know...reason and emotion, body, mind, environment; knowledge, action, change and power; science and society; ethics, polity and methodology; sustainability transitions; etc.
