

Share mobile data via the Wi-Fi Hotspot of your iPhone

You can share the mobile data network of your mobile phone when you do not have access to a Wi-Fi network.

Step 1: Activate the Wi-Fi-hotspot of your mobile phone.

- Go to Settings > Mobile Data or Settings > Personal hotspot.
- Slide the button next to Allow Others to Join.

Step 2: Connect your PC to the Wi-Fi network of your mobile phone.

- Open the list of Wi-Fi networks within reach on the other unit.
- Click on the name of the Wi-Fi-network of your mobile phone.
- Type the password of your phone's Wi-Fi-network.
- Click on Connect.

Share mobile data via Shared Internet or the Wi-Fi zone of your Android phone.

You can share the mobile data network of your mobile phone when you do not have access to a Wi-Fi network.

Sharing such a network connection is usually referred to as "Shared Internet" or "Wi-Fi Hotspot".

Most Android phones offer the option to share mobile data via Wi-Fi. Please note that your specific brand of Android phone may have a slightly different procedure for how to activate this option, and the exact wording as used on your mobile phone's menu may differ as well.

To use shared internet via your mobile phone's Wi-Fi Hotspot:

Step 1: Activate the Wi-Fi-hotspot of your mobile phone.

- Open Settings on your phone.
- Click on Network and Internet options -> Wi-Fi Hotspot or Shared Internet -> Wi-Fi-Hotspot.
- Activate Wi-Fi Hotspot.
- If you want to view or change a setting for the Wi-Fi network, for example, the name or the password, click on it. Only click on "Configure Wi-Fi-network" if it is necessary.

Step 2: Connect your PC to the Wi-Fi network of your mobile phone.

- Open the list of Wi-Fi networks within reach on the other unit.
- Click on the name of the Wi-Fi-network of your mobile phone.
- Type the password of your phone's Wi-Fi-network.
- Click on Connect.
